PERMIT IS VALID FOR ONE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31.
Permit/Application fee is \$5 for up to 6 chickens -- make check payable to City of Ladysmith
Permits purchased after January 1 in any given calendar year will also expire December 31
of that year. Permit fees will not be pro-rated.

REGULATIONS FOR KEEPING CHICKENS

Total number of hens to be kept: _____ (Maximum of 6 chickens are allowed per residential lot)
Roosters are not allowed. Commercial slaughtering of any fowl is prohibited. All chicken feed must be
kept in airtight containers that are inaccessible and out of the reach of wild animals and shall be stored
in vermin-proof containers.
