 - CN and WisDOT vision clearance setbacks do not allow mural to go on preferred location on west side of farmer's market. In fact, existing pavilion likely violates setbacks.

 - Permits needed and costs to prepare and review them.
 - Cost to design bridge.
11. Consider real elevated plow sign option for plow museum.

 - County Property Committee seemed to concur with idea, although ideas differ on exact placement.
