

JUNE 1, 2016 YOUTH AND RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

5:10 p.m. Council Chamber. Committee Members present: R. Moore, J. Pearson, M. Platteter. Others present: A. Christianson 1, A. Christianson 2 (Jaycees), K. Gorsegner, A. Kenyon, D. Parker.

Call to Order:

Mr. Platteter called the meeting to order.

Fireworks Contribution:

Motion was made by Pearson, seconded by Moore and carried by voice vote to recommend that the Finance Committee include \$3,000 for Mardi Gras fireworks in the initial draft of the 2017 general operations budget.

Beer Garden Hours:

It was reported that Lt. Julien called to say that LPD has no objection to the beer garden being open an hour later on Thursday evenings and noted officers will be at the Mardi Gras regardless. Motion was made by Moore, seconded by Platteter and carried by voice vote to recommend that the Council approve extend the Mardi Gras beer garden closing time from 10 to 11 p.m. in Thursday nights.

Seller's Permits:

Motion was made by Platteter, seconded by Moore and carried by voice vote, with Pearson abstaining, to discuss with the Council limiting issuance of seller's permits within 1,000 ft. of the Mardi Gras during its annual four day run for sellers whose offerings would be substantially the same as those offered at the Mardi Gras.

Tissue:

The Parks Dept. will see that an ample supply of tissue paper is available to the Jaycees to facilitate restocking restrooms after City workers have left the premises for the day.

ATV Access:

It was reported that Holiday plans to request that E. 6th St. N. be designated as an ATV route from Miner Ave. north to Holiday, which is apparently the only gas station that can't be reached by currently identified routes.
