  - d. Note that SEH has been asked to provide Proposal to prepare CDBG Planning Grant application for purpose of evaluating feasibility of converting either the LES or former Armory into a community center, which might include space leased for daycare use and other purposes supportive of employee recruitment and retention. This will include review of successful examples in other locales and a local needs assessment. This may or may not lead to a future request for implementation dollars.
  - e. Consider importance of programming that might be delivered through a community center.
