Highway 27 Rail Display Enhancements:

Mr. Reynolds noted that it seems that every couple of years, the rail cars that are not covered require maintenance to repair due to increased exposure to the elements. He felt that the permanent cover structures would be beneficial in reducing the weathering of the rail cars. Motion made by Reynolds, 2nd by Scheuller to find design for shelters for locomotive and 1st passenger car and bring to committee for review. Motion carried.

Electronic or Standard Business Directory Sign:

Mr. Groothousen distributed copies of a digital sign proposal given to the Ladysmith School District a few years ago. Mr. Reynolds questioned whether or not a flashing sign was needed or if a sign similar to the south industrial park could be used. He asked who the sign would be targeting and who would maintain the sign. Mr. Groothousen stated he would reach out to Main Street to discuss the sign further. No action taken.

Brief discussion was held about locations for current murals in storage. It was suggested that the committee drive around to look at possible mural locations at their next meeting. No action taken.
