

MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 25, 2022, JOINT MEETING OF THE PROPERTY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEES 5 p.m. Council Chamber. Members present: A. Christianson Sr., N. Johnson. Others present: A. Christianson Jr., K. Gorseger, A. Kenyon.

Call to Order:

Mr. Johnson called the meeting to order at 5:06 p.m. and presided.

Quonset:

There was discussion of what to do with the WWII vintage Quonset storage building assuming plans to develop the area where it is located with a 40-unit housing complex go forward. The PWD doesn't feel dismantling and relocating it would provide any advantage over constructing a comparably sized new building. Motion was made by Christianson Sr. seconded by Johnson and carried by voice vote to recommend to the Council that bids be sought for this structure, with bidders required to show proof of insurance and a performance bond.

Haunted House:

There was discussion of using part of the lower level of the former elementary school for a Northland Community Club "haunted house" this fall. Adm. Christianson and Mr. Johnson, who are both Club members, stated that it can be set up there without necessity of fastening to existing walls by means that would damage the walls. Motion was made by Christianson Sr., seconded by Johnson and carried by voice vote to recommend Council approval.

School Related Items:

Adm. Christianson described how, despite numerous items having already been sold or donated to area schools or non-profits, that a number of items such as obsolete desks remain that need to be gotten rid of. Motion was made by Christianson Sr., seconded by Johnson and carried by voice vote to recommend to the Council that on-line bids be sought for these remaining items.
