History: An "E"-mail was received October 11, 2011 from SEH that a grant to write a long-range management plan was approved by the Wisconsin DNR

The Corbett Lake – long management plan was completed and copies sent to the Rhinelander and Spooner WIS. DNR offices August 1, 2012

After submittal (28) activity folders have been created from information in the Long-range management plan.
